The Professional Support and Resource Fair will include:

1. Workshops focused on ways to engage your students in:
  - Learning in and across disciplines that fosters resilience (including for dual immersion and bilingual students)
  - Inquiring into environmental hazards and health issues as a first step for students to helping their communities rebuild
  - Reclaiming a sense of place and community
  - Understanding the changing and challenging relationships between people and their natural world
2. Opportunities to select FREE books and resources
  - Rebuild classroom and school libraries:
    - ✓ Informational books, fiction, graphic novels, and more across grade level spans K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12
    - ✓ Books and resources in Spanish or Spanish/English for dual immersion and bilingual classes
  - Replace instructional supplies:
    - ✓ Mathematics manipulatives
    - ✓ Supplies for Makerspaces or STEM classes
    - ✓ Art supplies
  - Rebuild educators' professional libraries with books that focus on:
    - ✓ supporting students through trauma; fostering resilience
    - ✓ teaching specific disciplines and implementing California Standards
    - ✓ supporting English learners, students with disabilities, or other special needs populations
3. Drawings for gift cards, conference registration packages, sets of books for school PLCs on teaching through trauma and fostering resilience, and more (attendance gives you your ticket; no purchase required)
4. Morning goodies and lunch
5. Connections with fellow educators from the nine California Subject Matter Projects who will describe CSMP support for your schools over the long haul of recovery
